## ✗ DO NOT THROW IN:

- SELECTIVELY COLLECTED WASTE
- WASTE ELECTRICAL AND ELECTRONIC EQUIPMENT
- BATTERIES AND STORAGE BATTERIES
- FLUORESCENT LAMPS AND ENERGY-SAVING BULBS
- WASTE ENGINE OIL AND OIL FILTERS
- PAINTS AND SOLVENTS AND THEIR PACKAGING
- CONSTRUCTION DEBRIS

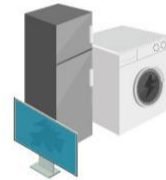

# SPECIAL PICK-UP WASTE

## ✓ PUT OUT:



• **FURNITURE AND OTHER BULKY WASTE:** furniture, prams, carpets, mattresses, bicycles, clothes dryers, door leaves, bathroom fixtures, etc.



• **WASTE HOUSEHOLD APPLIANCES:** washing machines, cookers, electric heaters and fans, vacuum cleaners, irons, computers, telephones, radios, television sets, etc.



• **WORN TYRES:** bicycle, motorcycle and car tyres from vehicles with a total weight of up to 3.5 tons.

## ✗ DO NOT PUT OUT:



• construction and demolition waste, tar paper

• installation parts, e.g. pipes, floor and wall panels



• hazardous waste (including chemicals and their packaging)

• car parts

• batteries and storage batteries

• other waste that is subject to selective collection

# PSZOK ("Gratowisko")

Selective Collection Point for Municipal Waste – PSZOK ("Gratowisko") is a place where residents – as part of the municipal waste management services for which they pay a fee – can hand over the following waste free of charge:

- EXPIRED FRUIT AND VEGETABLES
- PLANT RESIDUE
- BREAD
- EGG SHELLS
- COFFEE GROUNDS AND TEA LEAVES
- NON-IMPREGNATED WOOD
- BARK, SAWDUST, CHIPS
- MUSHROOMS

## ✘ DO NOT THROW IN:

- BIO-WASTE IN PLASTIC BAGS
- MEAT, BONES, FISH BONES AND ANIMAL DROPPINGS
- SOIL, STONES
- ASH
- WAFERBOARDS, FIREBOARDS AND THEIR SCOBS
- IMPREGNATED WOOD
- DEAD ANIMALS

- CAR WINDOWS
- FLUORESCENT LAMPS, BULBS
- PHARMACEUTICAL PACKAGING, THERMOMETERS
- EYEGGLASS LENSES
- SOLVENT AND ENGINE OIL GLASS PACKAGING
- VOTIVE CANDLES WITH WAX
